National Bison Association (NBA) will collect entry forms and entry fees.

A Consignor must be a NBA Active member prior to the sale. A certificate of veterinary inspection is required for each individual class and/or animal entry, plus FOUR copies of each certificate. Brucellosis testing: A negative blood test is required on all animals, except Official Calhhood Vaccinate (OCV) heifer calves. Tuberculosis Testing: All animals require a negative TB test. Anaplasmosis & Bluetongue: optional. Ivermectin: All animals must be injected with Ivermectin 10 to 12 days prior to the sale. All breeding age females must be pregnancy tested. **BVD testing: All bison must show a negative test for BVD-PI (persistently infected) before entering the show grounds.** An acceptable test performed by a licensed Veterinarian includes palpitation, blood test or ultra sound. Yearling Heifers are required to be open and this should be indicated on the health certificate along with observation date. Fertility Testing: All breeding age bulls must have a semen test on or after October 15, 2007.
