Llama Show Rules

1. Rules and Regulations: General Rules and Regulations apply to this division as well as those rules listed below.

2. The Llama Show is sponsored by the Rocky Mountain Llama and Alpaca Association and sanctioned by the Alpaca and Llama Show Association, Inc. All rules and guidelines for this show will be in accordance to ALSA. For ALSA membership information, contact the ALSA Office, 607 California Ave., Pittsburg, PA 15202.

3. This show is open to all Llama enthusiasts who wish to exhibit llamas.

4. Prior to making entries, all Participants are required to be familiar with the show rules, regulations and related information.

5. All Llamas must be at least five (5) months old. This rule also applies to Get-of-Sire and Produce-of-Dam classes.

6. **All animals in performance classes must be at least 12 months old.** All Llamas entered in approved halter and performance classes must be registered or have passed screening with the ILR or the CLRC. Copies of ILR registration paper mailed with entry. No Llama or Alpaca will be checked in without the copies of the Certificate.

7. Llamas may not be moved from one (1) Halter Class to another except at the discretion of the judge.

8. **LLAMA SHOW STALLS ARE LIMITED.** Stalls will be assigned by the Show Superintendent on a first come first serve basis by date of United States, Canadian or International Postal Service postmark (no postage meters accepted). Stalling requests will be honored as much as possible. No tack stalls provided.

9. Health Certificate: All Llamas must have an official health certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian in the state of origin, within thirty (30) days prior to the date of the show. This certificate must be available upon request by animal health officials or show superintendents. **All Llamas must be accompanied by a certificate of treatment for scabies within thirty (30) days prior to date of show. In addition, all Llamas must show a negative PI test for BVD. See Health Requirements on page 34.**

10. Only those Llama entered in the show are permitted on grounds.

11. **Fees: All fees must accompany entries, no exceptions.**

a. Entry fee: HALTER - Fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per animal per class per show. PERFORMANCE - Fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per animal per class. ALSA fee five dollars (\$5.00) per animal. Non-member ALSA Farm Fee thirty dollars (\$30.00) plus five dollars (\$5.00) per animal. Participant (owner/exhibitor) pass is required, one (1) per owner/exhibitor per show.

b. Twelve dollars (\$12.00) per animal per class for youth classes. (Youth eighteen (18) years old and under as of January 1, 2008). ALSA fee five dollars (\$5.00) per animal. All youth must receive prior permission from superintendent before entering open classes and be at least 14 years of age to enter open classes. Those youth, whose entry fees are paid in full, will be given one (1) Junior Participant (exhibitor) pass. All Canadian and International exhibitors must pay all fees in United States funds.

c. Stall Fee: Twenty-Five dollars (\$25.00) per stall. Stalls are 8' x 8' x 5'. Participants discretion as to number of animals per stall. Tack stalls may not be purchased.

- d. Parking Permits and Participant (owner/exhibitor) Passes. Refer to Fees.
- e. No Commercial Sales in the barn.

12. Entry forms: Use the entry form inserted in this premium list or request a form from the National Western Livestock Office at (303) 299-5559 or at www.nationalwestern.com.

13. Produce-of-Dam and Get-of-Sire animals must be entered in individual classes in order to compete in any group classes. No fee for group classes.

14. Ribbons will be awarded to the top eight (8) places. (ALSA points up to 7th)

15. This is a premium payout show based on a sliding scale.

Produce of Dam: Each entry must include two (2) offspring by the same dam. Produce may be represented by offspring of either sex. All produce must be shown in their appropriate halter class age division. There must be only one (1) entry per dam. The dam will not be shown in this class. The entry is made in the name of the dam. The produce and the respective sires must also be listed on the entry form.

Get-of-Sire: Each entry must include three (3) offspring by the same sire. Get may be represented by offspring of either sex. All Get must be shown in their appropriate halter class age division. Get must represent offspring by at least two different dams. There must be only one entry per sire. The Sire will not be shown in this class. The entry is made in the name of the Sire. The Get and the respective Dams must also be listed on the entry form.

Descriptions: No oral reasons will be given for Halter Placings.

Light Wool: Minimal body wool, short neck wool with smooth head, ears and legs.

Medium Wool: Moderate to long body wool, minimal to moderate neck wool, smooth to moderate head and leg wool.

Heavy Wool: Abundant body and neck wool with minimal to abundant head and leg wool, ie; wool at least to knee and hock.

Breeder Halter Divisions: Juvenile, 5 through 12 months; Yearling, 13 through 24 months; Two-Year-Old, 25 through 36 months; Adult, 37 months and older.

Non-Breeder Halter Classes: Two-Year-Old, 25 through 36 months; Adult, 37 months and older.

ALSA Youth Divisions: All ages are as of January 1, 2008. All points go to the youth and not the Llama. Youth 8 through 18 years of age may show intact males. It is recommended that Youth 8 through 12 years of age **not** show intact males over 24 months of age. **Juniors:** 8 years through 10 years of age. **Intermediate:** 11 years through 13 years of age. **Senior:** 14 years through 18 years of age.

AT ALL TIMES THE **PARTICIPANTS** WILL HAVE FULL CONTROL, CUSTODY AND WILL CARE, FEED AND KEEP SAFE THEIR ANIMALS, LIVESTOCK AND PERSONAL PROPERTY, ALL IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF NATIONAL WESTERN AND THE SHOW MANAGEMENT. The **Participants** further warrant that all copyright materials, to be performed or used during the term of this agreement, have been duly licensed or authorized by their copyright owners or agents and **Participants** agree to be responsible for all license and royalty fees incurred by reason of any performance or use of copyright materials and in addition to any provisions contained elsewhere in this agreement and premium book to indemnify and hold the **Stock Show** harmless from any and all losses and expenses incurred with regard thereto. The **Participants** will not be obligated to indemnify, defend or hold **Stock Show** harmless from any claim or demand which arises solely out of the negligent act or failure to act by **Stock Show**, its officers or employees.

In addition, **Participants** will indemnify and hold harmless the **Stock Show** for all damage, expenses or liabilities incurred as a result of any expenses, loss, claims, cost or any liability, including, but not limited to, consultant fees, legal or court cost, **Stock Show** management labor expenses and or cost, as well as expenses and or cost for blood, tissue, urine, hide and or carcass sampling and testing incurred as a result of **Stock Show** rule and regulation violations and all agreements herein, including, but not limited to unethical fitting, filling, meat tampering, illegal or non approved use of drugs, medication and or prohibited substance(s) as a result of **Participants** involvement in the **Stock Show**. **Participants** may also be subject to criminal charges.

Parent or guardian further acknowledges that they have read and explained to the **Participant** the Agreement of Responsibility and Liability and explained and cautioned the **Participant** on the penalties for prohibited substance, unethical fitting, sabotage and tampering of livestock.

If **Participant** is making an entry in the Junior Market Division, signature of the 4-H County Extension Agent or FFA Instructor is required certifying the **Participant** is a member in good standing; and by signing the National Western Stock Show entry form the 4-H County Extension Agent or FFA Instructor is stating they have read the National Western Stock Show General Rules and Regulations; Junior Livestock Show Rules and Regulations; Auction of Junior Livestock Champions Rules and Regulations; specific and/or special division rules and regulations; and The National Show Ring Code of Ethics and agree to observe and abide by these rules and regulations in respect to their participation. 4-H County Extension Agent or FFA Instructor further acknowledges that they have read and explained to the **Participant** the Agreement of Responsibility and Liability and explained and cautioned the **Participant** on the penalties for prohibited substance, unethical fitting, sabotage and tampering of livestock.
