1. Rules and Regulations: General Rules and Regulations apply to this division as well as those rules listed below and in specific breed divisions, ie: Angus, Charolais, Salers, etc.

2. Breeding Cattle. Judges are instructed to award prizes for breeding cattle in the different classes and in the order in which they, as buyers, would make selection for breeding purposes. The primary objective of the show is to encourage the breeding and feeding of improved breeds and types of livestock for well-defined practical purposes. In groups, encouragement will be given to uniformity of breed type.

3. Bull(s). A bull over one year of age without a ring in his nose will be excluded from exhibition at the discretion of Stock Show and in the interest of safety to spectators.

4. Breed Association Sales. All animals entered in the "Hill" sales must be entered in Stock Show classes and with the National Breed Association.

5. Breed Registration. Any animal entered in the Carload and/or Pen Division(s) in the "Yards" is not eligible to show in individual classes on the "Hill" and vice versa, unless specified otherwise within specific Livestock Breed Division(s).

1. National Western Stock Show will charge and collect an entry fee of thirty (\$30.00) dollars per head entered. All Canadian and International exhibitors must pay all fees in United States Funds.

2. Cattle entered must be registered in the Herd Book of the American Hereford Association. Polled and horned will show together in all miniature classes. Entries with registrations pending, illegible tattoos, or improper tattoos as shown on the registration certificate at check-in time are ineligible for competition. Maximum height to be shown in these classes is frame score 1 (one) on the extended graph of the AHA Chart; 45" on mature females, 48" on mature bulls. All entries will be measured at check in. Those exceeding the height requirement will be disqualified from competition.

3. Exhibitors with bulls born before January 1, 2007 in the sale or for sale are required to provide a licensed veterinarian's statement indicating the bull has been semen checked and evaluated as fertile. Semen evaluation is to occur within 90 days of the show. This statement must be presented at check-in during the National Western Stock Show.

4. **All exhibitors with animals in the sale, please see health requirements for cattle consignment sales beginning on page 33.**

5. Entries are subject to provisions and rules for showing as set forth by the AHA Board of Directors and are subject to supervision of the Show and Sale Committee representing the MHBA.

6. All exhibitors must be current members of the MHBA in order to be eligible to show.

Divided into 2 classes with natural age breaks considered

19. Cow/Calf Pair - any female older than the above ages with a calf at side. Calf must not be more than 270 days of age on the show date. Cow/Calf does not compete for Grand Champion.

PREMIUMS

First place in each class will receive one hundred (\$100) dollars and the remainder of the premium money will be awarded on a graduated basis among the other animals through 5th place after the show has been completed. The National Western Stock Show awards ribbons to all winners in each class through eight (8) places; Rosettes to all Division Champions and Reserve Champions and Banners to Grand Champions and Reserve Grand Champions.
